Annual EEO Public File Report

The purpose of this EEO Public File Report is to comply with Section 73.2080(c (6) of the FCC's 2002 EEO Rule. This report has been prepared on behalf of the Station Employment Unit that is comprised of the following stations: WBUT, WISR and WLER-FM, all licensed in Butler, Pennsylvania. The information contained in this report covers the time period beginning April 1, 2015 and continuing through March 31, 2016.

Activities

Section 1: Vacancy Information

There was one position filled during the past year. A full time account executive was hired. The successful candidate learned of the opening through on-air announcements. Two additional candidates were reviewed and interviewed – the main referral source was the job web site “butlercountyhelpwanted.com”. In addition to the station's individual websites, the position was advertised through the station's normal outreach sources.

Section 2: Recruitment Source Information

A review of the sources used to advertise open positions was completed and no changes were made, no additions were recommended.

Section 3: Supplemental Recruitment Activities

The station's staff participated in numerous activities to promote careers in broadcasting:

Staff conducted numerous tours of the radio facilities for community groups from pre-school to adults, providing the opportunity for station staff to discuss career opportunities and educational requirements. Tours were conducted by the Station's staff.

Station organized and conducted a broadcasting camp for high school students that was held July 13-17, 2016. Ten students attended the two-week “camp” that introduced participants to radio station operations and opportunities. Each student was given multiple opportunities to do “on-air” work throughout the experience.

Station staff attended several other business fairs during the past 12 months where staff had the opportunity to discuss career opportunities in broadcasting. The FM Program Director attended the Butler Junior High School career day on November 12, 2015. Vice President of Broadcast Operations did a presentation for Leadership Butler County regarding opportunities with the Butler Media Group and broadcasting in general in December.
